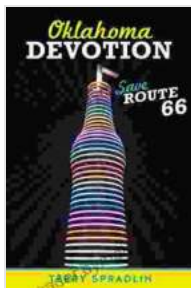


# An Oklahoma Devotion: Save Route 66

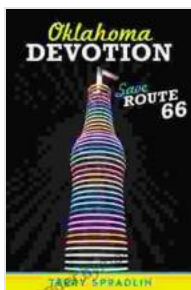

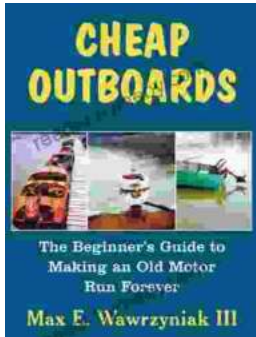
